Luke 5:12 And it happened when He was in a certain city, that behold, a man who was full of leprosy saw Jesus; and he fell on his face and implored Him, saying, “**Lord, if You are willing, You can make me clean.**” Then He put out His hand and touched him, saying, “**I am willing; be cleansed.**” Immediately the leprosy left him. (NKJV)

Luke 5:12-13 While He was in one of the towns, there came a man full of (covered with) leprosy; and when he saw Jesus, he fell on his face and implored Him, saying, Lord, **if You are willing**, You are able to cure me and make me clean. And [Jesus] reached out His hand and touched him, saying, **I am willing**; be cleansed! And immediately the leprosy left him. (AMP)

All of the tragedy and destruction and evil and bad things happening all over the planet is because man has a free will. Man has chosen to disobey and not believe God and do his own thing.

The Will of God is always no pain, no sorrow, no destruction. This has always been the Will of God.

What happens in people's lives doesn't prove the Will of God. God never changes and His Will doesn't change.

Psalm 91:16 With long life I will satisfy him, And show him My salvation.” (NKJV)

Psalm 91:16 With length of days I satisfy him, And I cause him to look on My salvation! (Young's Literal Translation)

Psalm 91:16 I will give them a long, full life, and they will see how I can save." (NCV)

How long is long? The Bible tells us how long is long.

Psalm 90:3-4 You turn man to destruction, And say, "Return, O children of men." **For a thousand years in Your sight Are like yesterday** when it is past, And like a watch in the night. (NKJV)

2 Peter 3:8 But, beloved, **do not forget** this one thing, that **with the Lord one day is as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day.** (NKJV)

Psalm 90:7-10 For we have been consumed by Your anger, And by **Your wrath we are terrified.** You have set our iniquities before You, Our secret sins in the light of Your countenance. For all our days have passed away in Your wrath; We finish our years like a sigh. The days of our lives are seventy years; And if **by reason of strength they are eighty years,** Yet their boast is only labor and sorrow; For it is soon cut off, and we fly away. (NKJV)

*This is **not** the description of living and obeying God. He is describing what is happening to the generations of Israel as they perish in the wilderness.*

Genesis 6:3 And the Lord said, "My Spirit shall not strive with man forever, for he is indeed flesh; **yet his days shall be one hundred and twenty years.**" (NKJV)

God says the days of man shall be 120 years. They will live only 120.

Genesis 6:3 "My Spirit will not put up with humans for such a long time, for they are only mortal flesh. **In the future, their normal lifespan will be no more than 120 years.**" (NLT)

Adam lived 930 years. Seth lived 912 years. Methuselah lived 969 years.

People were living almost a day in the beginning when the day equals 1,000 years in the beginning of creation. Our day has been reduced to 2 1/2 hours. 120 years would be less than 3 hours.

Jesus destroyed him who had the power of death. Christians shouldn't be afraid of death. Death now holds no fear.

Philippians 1:20-22 according to my earnest expectation and hope that in nothing I shall be ashamed, but with all boldness, as always, so now also **Christ will be magnified in my body, whether by life or by death.** For to me, **to live is Christ, and to die is gain.** But if I live on in the flesh, **this will mean fruit from my labor;** yet what I shall choose I cannot tell. (NKJV)

Philippians 1:20-22 This is in keeping with my own eager desire and persistent expectation and hope, that I shall not disgrace myself nor be put to shame in anything; but that with the utmost freedom of speech and unflinching courage, now as always heretofore, Christ (the Messiah) will be magnified and get glory and praise in this body of mine and be boldly exalted in my person, whether through (by) life or through (by) death. **For me to live is Christ [His life in me], and to die is gain [the gain of the glory of eternity].** If, however, it is to be **life in the flesh and I am to live on here,**

that means fruitful service for me; so I can say nothing as to my personal preference [I cannot choose], (The Amplified Bible)

Hebrews 9:27 And as it is appointed for men to die once, but after this the judgment (NKJV)

If the Lord tarries His coming just a couple hours we all will die. He is long-suffering. God isn't willing that any should perish.

Ecclesiastes 3:1-2 For everything **there is a season**, a time for every activity under heaven. **A time to be born and a time to die.** (NLT)

Job 5:26 You shall come to the grave at a **full age**, As a sheaf of grain ripens in its season. (NKJV)

Job 5:26 You shall come to your grave in **ripe old age**, and as a **shock of grain goes up** [to the threshing floor] in its season. (The Amplified Bible)

Ecclesiastes 7:17 Do not be overly wicked, Nor be foolish: **Why should you die before your time?** (NKJV)

Psalms 55:23 But You, O God, shall bring them down to the pit of destruction; **Bloodthirsty and deceitful men shall not live out half their days;** But I will trust in You. (NKJV)

Proverbs 3:1-2 My son, do not forget my law, But let your heart keep my commands; **For length of days and long life** And peace they will add to you. (NKJV)

Proverbs 4:10 Hear, my son, and receive my sayings, And the **years of your life will be many.** (NKJV)

Proverbs 9:10-11 The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, And the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding. **For by me your days will be multiplied, And years of life will be added to you.** (NKJV)

Proverbs 10:27 The fear of the Lord prolongs days, But the years of the wicked will be shortened. (NKJV)

Philippians 1:21-26 For to me, **to live is Christ, and to die is gain.** But if I live on in the flesh, this will mean fruit from my labor; yet what I shall choose I cannot tell. For I am **hard-pressed between the two, having a desire to depart and be with Christ, which is far better. Nevertheless to remain in the flesh is more needful for you.** And being confident of this, **I know that I shall remain and continue with you all for your progress and joy of faith,** that your rejoicing for me may be more abundant in Jesus Christ by my coming to you again. (NKJV)

You have a choice. You should say to yourself, "I HAVE A CHOICE".

2 Timothy 4:5-8 But you be **watchful** in all things, **endure** afflictions, **do the work of an evangelist, fulfill your ministry.** For I am already being poured out as a drink offering, and the **time of my departure is at hand. I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith.** Finally, there is **laid up for me the crown of righteousness,** which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will give to me on that Day, and not to me only but also to all who have loved His appearing. (NKJV)
