(NKJV)

**Luke 5:12-13** While He was in one of the towns, there came a man full of (covered with) leprosy; and when he saw Jesus, he fell on his face and implored Him, saying, Lord, **if You are willing**, You are able to cure me and make me clean. And [Jesus] reached out His hand and touched him, saying, **I am willing**; be cleansed! And immediately the leprosy left him. (AMP)

*In the Living Bible is written Jesus said **OF COURSE I WILL.***

**John 15:5-8** "I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing. If anyone does not abide in Me, he is cast out as a branch and is withered; and they gather them and throw them into the fire, and they are burned. If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you. By this My Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit; so you will be My disciples. (NKJV)

*Is the vine strong? If so, the branches should be strong? There is no corruption. There is no death in God. God is full of life. Do we have disease coming out of the vine into us?*

*We have a holy vine we are connected to. We have a pure vine.*

### **REASON 26 OUR BODIES ARE MEMBERS OF CHRIST**

#### **26. Our Bodies are Members of Christ**

**1 Corinthians 12:27** Now you are the body of Christ, and members individually. (NKJV)

**1 Corinthians 6:15** Do you not know that your bodies are members of Christ? Shall I then take the members of Christ and make them members of a harlot? Certainly not! (NKJV)

*Don't despise your body. God will redeem your body. God can assemble and He knows the molecules to make your body whole and He will have His glory flow over it.*

*Sickness costs company money. Sickness hinders the work of God. You don't need to be incapacitated. You have the work of the Lord to do.*

**1 Corinthians 6:19-20** Or do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and you are not your own? For you were bought at a price; therefore glorify God in your body and in your spirit, which are God's. (NKJV)

*Does God care what we do with our body? Yes He does.*

### **REASON 27 MY BODY IS A TEMPLE OF THE HOLY GHOST**

#### **27. My Body is a Temple of the Holy Ghost**

**1 Corinthians 3:9** For we are God's fellow workers; you are God's field, you are God's building. (NKJV)

*Does God want sickness in His house? Does God want His house infested with sickness?*

*He's clean, He's pure and He's holy and He needs a clean house.*

**1 Corinthians 3:16-17** Do you not know that you are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you? If anyone defiles the temple of God, God will destroy him. For the temple of God is holy, which temple you are. (NKJV)

**Leviticus 14:35-57** and he who owns the house comes and tells the priest, saying, 'It seems to me that there is some plague in the house,' then the priest shall command that they empty the house, before the priest goes into it to examine the plague, that all that is in the house may not be made unclean; and afterward the priest shall go in to examine the house. And he shall examine the plague; and indeed if the plague is on the walls of the house with ingrained

**streaks, greenish or reddish, which appear to be deep in the wall, then the priest shall go out of the house,** to the door of the house, and shut up the house seven days. And the priest shall come again on the seventh day and look; and indeed if the **plague has spread on the walls of the house,** then the priest shall command that they take away the stones in which is the plague, and they shall cast them into an unclean place outside the city. And he shall cause the house to be scraped inside, all around, and the dust that they scrape off they shall pour out in an unclean place outside the city. Then they shall take other stones and put them in the place of those stones, and he shall take other mortar and plaster the house. “Now **if the plague comes back and breaks out in the house,** after he has taken away the stones, after he has scraped the house, and after it is plastered, then the priest shall come and look; and **indeed if the plague has spread in the house,** it is an active leprosy in the house. It is unclean. And **he shall break down the house,** its stones, its timber, and all the plaster of the house, and **he shall carry them outside the city to an unclean place.** Moreover he who goes into the house at all while it is shut up shall be unclean until evening. And he who lies down in the house shall wash his clothes, and he who eats in the house shall wash his clothes. “But if the priest comes in and examines it, and indeed the plague has not spread in the house after the house was plastered, then **the priest shall pronounce the house clean,** because **the plague is healed.** And he shall take, to cleanse the house, two birds, cedar wood, scarlet, and hyssop. Then he shall kill one of

the birds in an earthen vessel over running water; and he shall take the cedar wood, the hyssop, the scarlet, and the living bird, and dip them in the blood of the slain bird and in the running water, and sprinkle the house seven times. And he shall cleanse the house with the blood of the bird and the running water and the living bird, with the cedar wood, the hyssop, and the scarlet. Then he shall let the living bird loose outside the city in the open field, and make atonement for the house, and it shall be clean. “This is the law for any leprous sore and scale, for the leprosy of a garment and of a house, for a swelling and a scab and a bright spot, to teach when it is unclean and when it is clean. **This is the law of leprosy.**” (NKJV)

*The clean Spirit should have a clean house. Stand up and say this isn't the Will of God and deny its right in my body.*

**Matthew 21:12-14** Then Jesus went into the temple of God and drove out all those who bought and sold in the temple, and overturned the tables of the money changers and the seats of those who sold doves. And He said to them, “It is written, ‘My house shall be called a house of prayer,’ but you have made it a ‘den of thieves.’” Then the blind and the lame came to **Him in the temple, and He healed them.** (NKJV)

*Does God want sickness in His house? The Holy Ghost lives in this house. What kind of house do you think He would be pleased to live in. There is no way sickness is the Will of God in His House.*

## REASON 28 WE ARE GOD'S PRIESTS

---

### 28. We are God's Priests

**Leviticus 21:16-23** And the Lord spoke to Moses, saying, "Speak to Aaron, saying: 'No man of your descendants in succeeding generations, **who has any defect**, may approach to offer the bread of his God. For any man **who has a defect** shall not approach: **a man blind or lame, who has a marred face or any limb too long, a man who has a broken foot or broken hand, or is a hunchback or a dwarf, or a man who has a defect in his eye, or eczema or scab, or is a eunuch.** No man of the descendants of Aaron the priest, who has a defect, shall come near to offer the offerings made by fire to the Lord. **He has a defect**; he shall not come near to offer the bread of his God. He may eat the bread of his God, both the most holy and the holy; only he shall not go near the veil or approach the altar, because he has a defect, lest he profane My sanctuaries; for **I the Lord sanctify them.**'" (NKJV)

*It wasn't the Will of God for these people to be born that way. Everything on this planet has been effected by the curse. There is no such thing as a perfect body because of sin and the curse.*

**Revelation 1:5-6** and from Jesus Christ, the faithful witness, the firstborn from the dead, and the ruler over the kings of the earth. To Him who loved us and washed us from our sins in His own blood, **and has made us kings and priests** to His God and Father, to Him be glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen. (NKJV)

**Revelation 5:10** And have made us kings and priests to our God; And we shall reign on the earth." (NKJV)

**Leviticus 22:19-25** you shall offer of your own free will a male **without blemish** from the cattle, from the sheep, or from the goats. Whatever has a defect, you shall not offer, for it **shall not be acceptable** on your behalf. And whoever offers a sacrifice of a peace offering to the Lord, to fulfill his vow, or a freewill offering from the cattle or the sheep, **it must be perfect** to be accepted; there **shall be no defect in it.** Those that are **blind or broken or maimed, or have an ulcer or eczema or scabs**, you shall not offer to the Lord, nor make an offering by fire of them on the altar to the Lord. Either a bull or a lamb that has any limb too long or too short you may offer as a freewill offering, but for a vow it shall not be accepted. 'You shall not offer to the Lord what is bruised or crushed, or torn or cut; nor shall you make any offering of them in your land. Nor from a foreigner's hand shall you offer any of these as the bread of your God, **because their corruption is in them, and defects are in them.** They shall not be accepted on your behalf.' " (NKJV)

## REASON 29 OUR BODIES ARE LIVING SACRIFICES

---

### 29. Our Bodies are Living Sacrifices

**Romans 12:1-2** I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the **mercies of God**, that you **present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service.** And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may

prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God. (NKJV)

*What if your body is in an unacceptable condition? It's not the sheep that was unacceptable. It was the sickness.*

**Luke 17:11-19** Now it happened as He went to Jerusalem that He passed through the midst of Samaria and Galilee. Then as He entered a certain village, there met Him ten men who were lepers, who stood afar off. And they lifted up their voices and said, "**Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!**" So when He saw them, He said to them, "**Go, show yourselves to the priests.**" And so it was that **as they went, they were cleansed.** And one of them, when he saw that he was healed, returned, and with a loud voice glorified God, and fell down on his face at His feet, giving Him thanks. And he was a Samaritan. So Jesus answered and said, "Were there not ten cleansed? But where are the nine? Were there not any found who returned to **give glory to God** except this foreigner?" And He said to him, "Arise, go your way. **Your faith has made you well.**" (NKJV)

*You have a High Priest passed into the heavens. Present your body to Jesus as acceptable. Call your body healed and as you go you will be healed.*

### **REASON 30 WE ARE THE BRIDE OF CHRIST**

---

#### **30. We are the Bride of Christ**

**1 Corinthians 11:7** For a man indeed ought not to cover his head, since **he is the image and glory of God**; but **woman is the glory of man.** (NKJV)

*How many men want their wives sick? Sickness effects beauty and radiance. The husband and wife are a type of Christ and the Church.*

*He will never say it pleases Him to have you sick as His Bride.*

**Ephesians 5:25-33** Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself for her, that **He might sanctify and cleanse her with the washing of water by the word, that He might present her to Himself a glorious church, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but that she should be holy and without blemish.** So husbands ought to love their own wives as their own bodies; he who loves his wife loves himself. For no one ever hated his own flesh, but nourishes and cherishes it, just as the Lord does the church. **For we are members of His body, of His flesh and of His bones.** "For this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh." **This is a great mystery, but I speak concerning Christ and the church.** Nevertheless let each one of you in particular **so love his own wife as himself,** and let the **wife see that she respects her husband.** (NKJV)
